

Data Sheet 7 (DS 007) Accessible Public Toilets

What are we monitoring?

The number of accessible public toilets in the Blue Mountains. Accessible toilets are those that have: wheelchair accessibility, hold rails and ramp access where required. This measure does not include public toilets located within public facilities with limited opening times such as libraries and community centres.


What is the trend?

Between 2009 and 2015 the number of public toilets listed on the National Toilet map in the Blue Mountains remained steady at 64. The proportion of toilets that had accessibility features increased from 15 (23%) to 20 (31%).

Why is monitoring this trend important?

Public toilets that are accessible to all members of the population improve the inclusiveness of our community and provide greater support to residents and visitors requiring such accessible facilities.
