What are we monitoring?

The number of lost time injuries per year that occur within the workforce at Blue Mountains City Council.

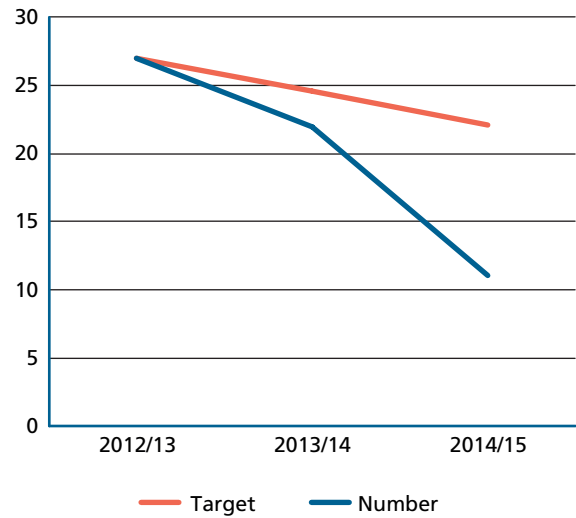
What is the trend?

The trend is moving in the right direction, downward and towards the long term target set in 2013 for the Council to have nil lost time workplace injuries by 2023. The Council is performing better than the annual phased reduction target.

Why is monitoring this trend important?

The workplace lost time injury rate is a fundamental workplace health and safety measure, which can demonstrate the fulfilment of an organisation's duty of care and the ongoing effectiveness of an organisation's management of safety. Lower injury rates potentially can also save Council money in workers' compensation premiums.
